

LIEPĀJA TRIP



Liepāja - an important settlement on the Eastern coast of the Baltic Sea located between the sea and Lake Liepāja, where people have lived for more than 750 years. Liepāja is a town of music and culture where the events of the year 2005 will be dedicated to the 380th anniversary of the town. Participate in Liepāja's music festivals "Liepājas dzintars" and "Beach party" or other musical events that are offered at the town's music clubs. Walk the labyrinths of the Northern Fort; discover the nature of Karosta's (Naval Port) architecture or the former prison, look at Art-Nouveau buildings in the town centre and distinctive wooden architecture in Seaside Park.

On sunny days the Blue flag beach and Seaport promenade and Fame avenue of Latvian musicians, are obvious attractions, while in cloudy weather bowling alleys, the cultural centre k@2 or Liepāja Theatre offer alternatives. Liepāja is a town that inspires; with high class service is in the cozy hotels, stylish cafes and cheerful taverns.

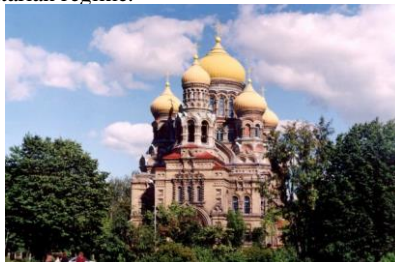
